## ***From the Chairperson's desk***

Dear Friends,

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that the Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council has put its best foot forward to ensure that we are in a position to contribute significantly to the success of the *Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana* (PMKVY) being formally launched on July 15.

We have already affiliated more than 50 Vocational Training Providers nationwide, so that young men and women across the length and breadth of the country could benefit from the PMKVY – the world's biggest skills training initiative of its kind.

As part of our PMKVY preparedness, 113 job roles have been finalized across five sub-sectors and 12 Qualification Packs have been approved by the Qualifications Review Committee for the purpose of roll-out.

Most importantly, we have already mobilized and started training of nearly 100% of the target of 22,700 people that we have been allocated under the pilot phase of the PMKVY. By the time you read this, the Beauty & Wellness Sector Council would have achieved 100% of the mobilization target for the pilot phase. We are planning to approach the NSDC and the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship to allocate additional numbers to us under the *Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana*.

The Government and the NSDC have reposed a lot of faith in our ability to emerge as a stand-out performer in the PMKVY initiative. I would like to take this opportunity to assure all stakeholders that the Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council will live up to expectations.

Given that the Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council is privileged to be part of both the Steering Committee and the Sub-Committee on the PMKVY, we will continue to use these platforms to promote the cause of women empowerment through skill development.

The WorldSkills 2015 competition is just a month from now. I am happy to inform you that the training of the Indian contestants in the Beauty Therapy and Hair Dressing disciplines are progressing splendidly. Apart from domain training, we are also organizing mind training workshops for them so that they are in the best frame of mind for the tough test that awaits them in Sao Paulo in August.

The first 'Beauty & Wellness Day' celebration is planned for September. We are planning to flag off the selection process for WorldSkills 2017 from there. At the Governing Council, we have already started brainstorming on how we could make the 'Beauty & Wellness Day' a great success.

At the Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council, we have always been deeply committed to promoting social inclusion through skill development. We have started training the transgender community to help them integrate with the mainstream. We are also the only Sector Skill Council which is operational in the north-eastern state of Mizoram. I can assure you that we will have a lot more happy news to share on this front in the coming days.

## Occupational Mapping

B&WSSC NOS Committee meeting was conducted in Delhi. One Hundred and Thirteen job roles across the five sub-sectors were approved by NOS Committee. The One Hundred and Thirteen job roles have been created after on-the-shop floor survey conducted by E&Y and validated by the industry.



## PMKVY Update

- B&WSSC was assigned 22,700 nos. in the Pilot phase. 100% target achieved.
- 56 Training partners participating in the pilot phase spread across 25 states including Mizoram in North East
- Training being conducted in 3 qualification Packs - Assistant Beautician, Assistant Hair Stylist and Pedicurist & Manicurist
- In-house PMKVY Team created for daily coordination and to resolve any problem faced by the training partners



## SCERT Train-the-Trainer

B&WSSC has worked very closely with SCERT. B&WSSC has validated SCERT course curriculum in Beauty & Wellness for class 9 and created the course curriculum for 11 & 12 standard. A train-the-trainer initiative was conducted at SCERT campus for the faculty, One Hundred and Two trainers of Beauty & Wellness underwent training by our Head Master Trainer.



## Qualification Packs

The Qualification Registration Committee (QRC) has approved Twelve qualification packs developed across our five sub-sectors. QRC is the highest body that approves any Qualification Pack before any Sector Skill Council starts conducting training in it.

## Train-the-Trainer

Two train-the-trainer initiative was conducted in Chennai for our training partners Arthi Academy, Reep Trust, Laurus EduTech Private Ltd. and Trends in Vogue. The training was conducted in two qualification pack - Assistant Beautician & Assistant Hairstylist. A total of Forty Seven trainers were trained to conduct training in the two qualification packs.
